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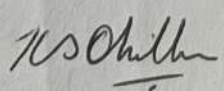
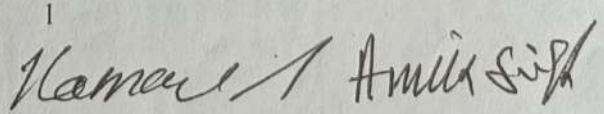
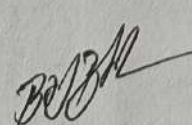
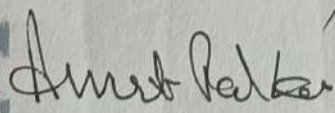
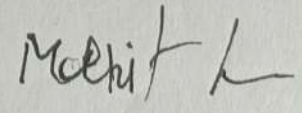
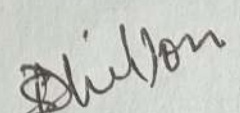
TRUST DEED

Karanvir Singh Dhillon, the First Party along with Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth and Ninth parties as aforesaid, are hereinafter collectively referred to as "BOARD OF TRUSTEES" OR "BOARD" OR "TRUSTEES" OR "FIRST TRUSTEES", which term whenever the context permits shall mean and include the persons constituting the Board of Trustees from time to time and each of the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh, Eighth and Ninth parties herein are hereinafter individually called "MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES" (which term shall unless inconsistent with or repugnant to the subject or context thereof include their heirs, executors and administrators).

WHEREAS the Author of the Trust or The Founder is desirous of constituting an educational trust in the name of "Baba Chuhar Singh Memorial Educational Trust" for imparting and promoting education by establishing schools and fulfilling other incidental /

WHEREAS the Author is possessed of and entitled to a sum of Rs. 51,000/- (Rupees Fifty One thousand Only) and hereby declare and settle the said amount as a fund for the trust and entrust the same in favor of the Trustees for administration of the Trust so created in terms of the present Trust Deed.

WHEREAS the Trustees hereto have given their consent to be the Trustees for administration of the affairs of the Trust in accordance with the terms and conditions hereunder provided.

NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That the Trust hereby established shall be called as "Baba Chuhan Singh Memorial Educational Trust" (hereinafter called "The Trust").
2. The registered office of the Trust shall be situated at 2nd Floor, Dhillon Market, Chandigarh Road, Samrala, Ludhiana, Punjab or such other place in India, as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.
3. The benefits of the trust shall be open to all the persons, irrespective of their caste, creed, sex or religion on secular basis.

4. TRUST TO BE IRREVOCABLE:

The trust hereby established shall be irrevocable.

5. CORPUS OF THE TRUST:

It shall constitute of the initial sum of Rs. 51,000/- (Rupees Fifty One Thousand Only) as settled by the Author and any contribution, donations, gifts and bequests etc., made to the Trust and the Trustees shall hold the said fund and income there from in the Trust to be utilized only for the objects of the Trust.

6. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

That the aims and objects of the Trust shall be in the nature of charitable/educational character within the meaning of Section 2(15) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as amended from time to time, which are broadly stated as under:-

- (i) To provide education at all levels, encourage to all classes of people at all levels irrespective of caste, creed, sex, age, community or religion and other like objects at various places in India and abroad.
- (ii) To establish, maintain and/or run educational institution(s), industrial/vocational training centers, to aid, assist and support students by way of stipend, scholarship, supply of books, medals, payment of their fees and other incentives to study and to promote the advance of education to general public without caste, creed and religion.
- (iii) To spread useful educational, literacy, scientific and technical knowledge etc. and promote education and learning in all its branches in such manner as the Board of trustees may think.
- (iv) To start research centers and institutions of the like nature in India or abroad for use of students and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general within the frame work of govt. guidelines.

- (v) To improve quality education by preparation and usage of innovative learning material and adopting scientific teaching, techniques and technologies through remedial education classes. To create

opportunities of imparting moral education for inculturation of the students, so as to make them active, responsible and faithful citizens of the nation.

- (vi) To promote, support, establish, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts, for the preservation of Indian culture and for the research and also for other institutions having similar objects for the benefits of the students and general public.
- (vii) To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled persons and to provide them education food, clothing, medical and other help to make their life good and also awarding scholarship and cash payments to poor persons and widows, deserving students by giving primary, secondary and higher education.
- (viii) To establish, maintain and operate schemes for studentships, scholarships and render other types of aids to students including supply of books, stipends, grants and other types of aids to students including supply of books, stipends, grants and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, colour, race, creed or sex.
- (ix) To maintain orphanages and homes for old, aged, enfeebled, disabled, widows, widowers, infirm, blind, handicapped and destitute persons and to provide them education and training and to render assistance to any such existing institution and/or individual.
- (x) To engage in social, cultural, educational and moral activities or any other activities which contribute to the total development of the human personality, for the benefit of all people without discrimination of caste, creed, nationality, sex, religion or community.
- (xi) To organize and arrange exhibitions, functions, seminars, cultural entertainment events, competitions, benefit shows and similar other programs such as training, camps, field trips, lectures, conferences etc.
- (xii) To establish hostels, student homes run free or subsidized for the students and weaker sections of the society.
- (xiii) To work and promote educational standards, impart basic, elementary, secondary, supplementary and adult formal and non formal education programme for the school drop outs, transit schools for the street children and child labourers and adult education and financial literacy programmes and also run model educational institutions training schools and coaching at various levels.
- (xiv) The Funds and the Income of the TRUST shall be solely utilized for the achievements of its objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to trustees by way of profit, interest dividend etc.
- (xv) Any other object of general public utility in relation to incidental to or ancillary to the above written objects not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit.

7. That notwithstanding anything hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, the income as well as corpus of the Trust Fund shall be applied and be applicable only to and/or for such charitable purposes as are recognized under the Income Tax Act, 1961 and/or any other Act governing Taxation of Income and as will ensure or make the Trust hereby established and its income eligible for exemption from taxation.

The management of the Trust shall vest in hands of the Board of Trustees which shall consist of minimum 2 (two) and maximum 9 (Nine) trustees as appointed in terms of this Trust Deed.

(a) LIFETIME TRUSTEES

Sh. Karanvir Singh Dhillon shall be lifetime trustee forthwith, who shall be trustee on the Board of Trustees of the Trust during his lifetime having vote rights, which shall not subsist after his death.

(b) TERM TRUSTEES

The first board of Trustees excluding the lifetime trustees shall be 'Term Trustees' for a period of 1 (One) year from the date of creation of trust and shall be eligible for subsequent reappointments annually on annual basis in Annual General Meetings till the time they are appointed as permanent trustees. Any new trustee appointed in the Board of Trustees shall be a term trustee initially for a period of one year and shall be eligible for subsequent reappointments annually on annual basis. The term of term trustees shall be 1 (one) year and are eligible for subsequent reappointments annually on annual basis. The reappointments shall be considered in annual general meetings, whereas, new/fresh appointments may be made at any time during the year by the simple majority of the Board of Trustees. The appointment of new term trustees shall be subject to the maximum number of trustees as stated aforesaid.

(c) PERMANENT TRUSTEES

The board of Trustees may appoint a 'Term Trustee' as a Permanent Trustee, who has served for a period of 3 years' consecutively as a term trustee. However, without prejudice to the aforesaid, the board of Trustees may appoint any person directly as a Permanent Trustee or refuse to appoint such eligible person as permanent trustee by simple majority, subject to the maximum number of trustees as stated aforesaid. Such appointments/decisions shall be made/taken in Annual General Meetings. Permanent Trustees shall continue to be trustees on the Board of Trustees subject to their removal/retirement in terms of the provisions mentioned hereinafter and the provisions of reappointment are not applicable on permanent trustees.

9. RETIREMENT

A trustee (i) resigning of his own free will or (ii) becoming an insolvent or (iii) becoming of unsound mind or (iv) if held guilty of any offence involving moral turpitude or (v) due to his/her death, shall be deemed to have retired. Any vacancy arising on account of retirement of trustees may be filled up by the Board of Trustees.

10. REMOVAL/EXPULSION OF TRUSTEES

Any Trustee (i) Falling to attend 3 consecutive meeting without leave; or (ii) working against the aims and objects of the Trust; or (iii) causing any hindrance in smooth working of the Trust, shall be removed from the Board of Trustees by a decision of simple majority of Trustees in the Board's meeting called for that purposes. However, clause (i) shall not apply to trustees residing outside India.

11. OFFICE BEARERS

PRESIDENT

The Trustees shall elect/appoint a President for a period of three years' who shall act as the President of the Trust. The incumbent shall be eligible for reselection/reelection.

The duties of the President shall be as under:

- (a) To preside over the meetings of the Board of Trustees.
- (b) To confirm the proceedings of the meeting and keep general discipline and harmony in the Trustees.
- (c) To appoint Chairman and members of different committees.
- (d) To function as the administrative head of the trustees.
- (e) To expend Rs. 50,000/- without the prior approval of the Board of Trustees.
- (f) To do all such acts and deeds necessary and incidental to proper functioning of the Trust and for achieving its objectives.

In event of vacancy on account of death or resignation of President, the Trustees by a decision of majority may elect any person as the President for the remaining term for conducting day to day work of the Trust and till new election.

VICE PRESIDENT:

The Trustees shall elect/appoint a Vice President of the Trust for a period of three year at a time. The incumbent shall be eligible for re-election. The Vice President shall exercise all such powers and duties of the President in the absence of President/or such powers as may be delegated to him by the president.

GENERAL SECRETARY:

The Trustees may elect/appoint a General Secretary of the Trust for a period of three year at a time. The incumbent shall be eligible for re-election.

The duties of the General Secretary shall be as under:

- (a) To convene meetings in consultation with the President, frame agenda, maintain regular records of the proceedings of the meetings of Trust.
- (b) To prepare the annual report, conduct correspondence and perform all such current duties which are connected with such reports.
- (c) To expend Rs. 25,000/- without the prior approval of the Board of Trustees.

SECRETARY:

The Trustees shall elect/appoint a Secretary for a period of three year at a time. The incumbent shall be eligible for re-appointment. The Secretary shall exercise all such powers and duties of the General Secretary in the absence of General Secretary/or such powers as may be delegated to him by the president.

FINANCE SECRETARY:

The Trustees shall elect/appoint a Finance Secretary for a period of three year at a time. The incumbent shall be eligible for re-appointment.

The duties of the Finance Secretary shall be as under:

- (a) To maintain Books of Accounts.
- (b) To acknowledge the receipts and disburse the sanctioned payments.

12. MANAGING COMMITTEE

There shall be a managing committee of the other members to be elected by the Board of Trustees. The Managing committee shall carry out the project taken by the trust.

13. POWERS AND RIGHT OF TRUSTEES

For the accomplishment of the objects of the Trust of these present and without prejudice to the generality of any power hereby or by law conferred or implied or vested in the trustees, the following powers and authorities are hereby expressly conferred on the Board of Trustees:

(A) INCOME/PROPERTY OF TRUST

The Board of Trustees are hereby authorized to invite or accept donations of money, shares, debentures, bonds, securities and other movable or immovable property from the founder or anyone else by way of grant, legacy or otherwise on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may think fit, not being inconsistent with the terms of these presents and such donations shall be held by the Trustees as accretion to and augmentation of the Trust and shall be subject to the same terms, power and provision as are contained in these presents and thereof as if such money or other property had formed part of the original trust fund, provided that the Trustees may refuse to accept any such donation, grant or legacy which they may in their absolute discretion consider unsuitable.

(B) UTILIZATION OF TRUST PROPERTY:

All the properties of the Trust together with any income thereof shall be held in Trust by the Trustees and applied for the purposes of the Trust. The funds and income of the Trust shall be solely utilized for the achievement of its objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to the trustees by way of profit, interest, dividend etc.

(C) BORROW MONEY:

The Board of Trustees shall have the power to borrow or secure the payment of money borrower in such manner as the board may think fit.

(D) INVESTMENT:

The funds of the Trust shall be invested in the modes specified under provisions of Section 13(1) (d) read with Section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time and as per Central Government notifications/circulars etc. in this regard.

(E) HIRE PROPERTY:

- (i) The trustees shall have power to hire, take on lease any movable or immovable property for the purposes of the Trust on such terms and conditions and for such period as they consider fit.

- (ii) The trustees shall have power to let out any movable or immovable property of the Trust on such terms and conditions and for period or purposes as they may consider necessary.

(F) ACQUIRE PROPERTY:

The Board of Trustees may acquire movable/immovable properties by way of purchase, exchange, lease, gift or otherwise and construct, acquire, demolish or build any immovable property for/of the Trust and/or make additions, alterations, improvements and developments thereto as they may consider fit.

(G) TO OPEN BANK ACCOUNT & ITS OPERATION:

The Board of Trustees shall have the power to open current, saving, fixed deposits or other accounts(s) with Bank(s). The Bank a/c of the Trust shall be opened in the name of Trust and shall be operated with the signatures of any two persons out of President, Vice President, General Secretary, Secretary or Finance Secretary out of which one must be Finance Secretary. No trustee, however, shall have the authority to freeze the Bank Account without the approval of Board of Trustees by means of a proper resolution.

(H) APPOINT COMMITTEES:

For effectively carrying out the aims of the trust, the Managing Committee shall have power to appoint different committee/sub-committee for some particular or defined object/projects. Such committee/sub-committee may contain certain well meaning, energetic and job oriented persons from the public comprising of even number members. At least one of the members of such committee/sub-committee shall be a trustee/office bearer of the trust. Such committee shall be answerable to the trust and shall report its activities to the trust. Finances if any generated shall be deposited with finance secretary against proper receipt.

(I) EX-OFFICIO MEMBERS:

The trust may nominate/appoint ex-officio members of the trust by virtue of his holding some important position/office in governmental/non-governmental bodies or institutions.

(J) PATRONS, ADVISORS & SPECIAL INVITEES:

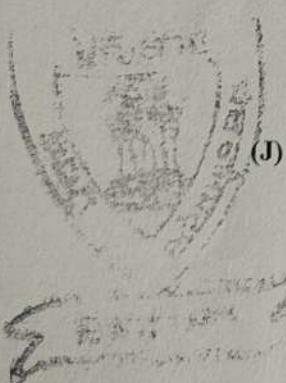
The trust may nominate/appoint certain eminent persons from the fields of education, science, technology, law or any other specified field and philanthropists as their patrons, advisors or special invites. Such persons shall have an advisory role with no right to vote. They may attend the meetings of the meetings of the trust as and when invited.

(K) POWER TO APOINT STAFF:

The President shall have the power to appoint and dismiss and reappoint Principal(s), Teacher(s), executives, officials, clerks, caretakers, attendants and other employees on such terms as they think fit.

(L) POWER TO AMEND TRUST DEED:

The Trustees shall have power by $\frac{3}{4}$ th majority of the trustees present at a meeting to frame, add, alter, modify, repeal, amend or substitute any clause, rule or regulation contained herein the trust deed or framed hereafter provided such Rules, Regulations or provisions do not offend the

basic structure of the trust. The rules so framed may be attached at the end of the trust deed and resolution number.

(M) **REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES:**

The Trustees may be reimbursed out the Trust fund such expenses legitimately incurred in furtherance of the purposes of the Trust. The evidence/vouchers shall have to be submitted and approved.

(N) **TRUSTEES NOT TO DERIVE BENEFIT DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY:**

The trustees shall not be paid any sitting fee or remuneration or reimbursement of any expenses in connection with attending any meetings of the Trust. The Trustees shall also not derive any benefit, financial or otherwise from the Trust. Deriving any such benefit shall immediately disentitle the Trustee from membership of the Trust.

(O) **DECISION MAKING:**

The Board of Trustees shall act according to the decisions of the majority of the Trustees of Board when they are not unanimous and such decisions shall be binding on the minority as well as those Trustees who may not have voted. If Trustees are equally dividend in opinion, the matter shall be decided according to the casting vote of the presiding chairman.

(P) **DELEGATION OF POWERS:**

The Trustees for the time being may delegate all or any of their powers to any trustees and or the office bearers of the trust jointly or severally as may be deemed necessary from time to time.

(Q) **MEETINGS:**

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS

The board of trustees shall meet at least twice in a year or at such frequent intervals as the Trustees may determine. One of these meeting will be called ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING wherein annuals accounts shall be approved and elections/nominations/cooption etc. if any due shall also be held.

CHAIRMAN OF THE MEETING:

In the absence of President of the Trust, such absence having been conveyed in writing before hand, such of the trustee as may be elected by the trustees shall be the chairman of the meetings as and when held.

NOTICE:

Notice of at least 7 clear days before the day of meeting, stating the place, date and hour of the meeting and principal business to be transacted at the meeting, shall be given in writing to every trustee. Accidental omission to give such notice to any trustee shall, however, not invalidate the proceedings of the meeting.
